▪ Purbanchal College, Silapathar: An overview

Purbanchal College, Silapathar (formerly known as Silapathar Commerce College) was founded by the people of Silapathar way back in the year 1996, with a hope of imparting quality education in both Arts and Commerce Stream and has successfully traced a path of continuous progress since last 23 years catering to the needs of the poor and needy knowledge seekers of the locality.

▪ Infrastructure

Ambience

The college has a very calm environment far away from the hubbub of the town which is congenial for learning. It is in a rural backdrop from where we have a fascinating view of the hills of Arunachal Pradesh in the North and beautiful green fields in the East. There is also adequate physical resource to cater the needs of the students. There are different departmental class rooms for each department with well equipped laboratories for subjects with practical.

Administrative Block

The college has a well equipped administrative block where the activities like admission, form fill up, issue of forms or any other such matters are tackled. It has a computerized student management system with adequate number of staff. The Principal’s office is set in this administrative block.



College Library

The library of the college is in the first floor of the administrative block. It is a modern library with good number of books, journals and newspapers to cater the needs of the learners. It has a computerized programme for keeping record of issue and receipt of the books. It has also a well furnished reading room with Wi-Fi facility for the readers and remains open from 09.30 am to 4.00 pm on all working days. Books are issued to students on production of library card and are permitted to be kept for 15 days which can be renewed after that.

Laboratory

The college has four departments with practical subjects, namely Geography, Education, Mathematics & Statistics. The Department of Geography & Education have separate laboratories with all modern tools and equipments which are necessary for the students.

Canteen

The college has a beautiful canteen where students and visitors can get good and healthy food. The canteen is an eye-catcher as it is located in the right hand corner of the entrance gate from where everyone can have access to the facility.

Girls' Hostel

The college has a double storied girls' hostel for girl student from distance places studying in the college. Hostel admission is provided only on application in prescribed format which is available in the college office. The hostel is within the college campus which is guarded by high boundary walls and round the clock security. 24 hours water supply and power supply (backup generator facility) is provided in the hostel.

Sports Complex

There is a 4 (four) Bighas outdoor sports complex which facilitates the playing of outdoor games like football, cricket and athletics. It also has an indoor stadium where the students can play various indoor games along with badminton. The college has also a multi-gym which is well equipped with all modern equipments like, treadmill, exercise cycle, adjustable sit-up bench, multi bench and other tools of fitness. It will also be used as a facility for other games like badminton and other indoor games.

Auditorium

An auditorium with a sitting capacity of 100 (one hundred) persons is available in the college. It is equipped with high quality sound system, LCD projector and portable projector screen where conferences, presentations and lectures in front of august audience are conducted. It also serves as the college auditorium where ceremonies like freshmen social, prize distribution and other activities are done.

Academic Schedule:

The Academic Schedule of the UG Programmes, (Four Year Under Graduate Programmes) in Arts (B.A) and Commerce (B.Com) under the NEP are going on and administered as per the Academic Calendar of the University published for every academic session.

Admission Criteria:

- (i) Newspaper, Notice and Advertisement in the college website (www.purbanchalcollege.ac.in) inviting applications for admission into the different programmes shall be issued by the Principal of the college/institute as per the Academic Calendar of Dibrugarh University. The minimum eligibility for admission into the following Programmes shall be as below:
 - a. Bachelor of Arts (B.A.):** A student passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council, or an equivalent examination (10+2) recognized as such by the University.
 - b. Bachelor of Commerce (B.Com.):** A student passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in Commerce stream of the Assam Higher Secondary Education Council, or an equivalent examination (10+2) recognized as such by the University. A student passed the Higher Secondary Examination (10+2) in Science stream with Mathematics and/or Statistics is also eligible to apply for admission.
- (ii) The admission or eligibility criteria shall be fixed by the Academic Council of Dibrugarh University from time to time whenever necessary. The University/colleges/institutes may also adopt its own policy for admission or selection of eligible candidates for admission complying with the eligibility criteria prescribed in the clause 2.5(i).

- (iii) No student shall be eligible for admission to an Academic Programme in any discipline unless he/she has successfully passed the qualifying examination fulfilling the minimum eligibility criteria from a University/Institute recognized by Dibrugarh University.
 - (iv) Statutory reservation policy of the government shall be followed in case of selection of eligible candidates for admission.

Attendance

- The course teacher shall be responsible for maintaining a record of attendance of students who have enrolled for the course.
- All course teachers shall intimate the Principal of the college/Institute through the Head of the Department concerned at least thirty calendar days before the last instruction day in the semester, the particulars of all students who have less than 80% of attendance during the total number of class days.
- A student who has less than 80% attendance in average shall not be permitted to sit for the End-semester examination.
- Provided that it shall be open to the University to grant exemption to a student who has attended a minimum of 70% classes but failed to obtain the prescribed 80% attendance for valid reasons, on recommendation of the Head/Principal of the Department/College on payment of a prescribed fee(s).
- A student declared as discollegiate shall not be allowed to proceed to the next higher Semester. He/She shall need to pursue the Semester afresh in which he/she was declared as discollegiate along with the next fresh batch.

▪ Admission Procedure

Application form can be collected from the college office free of cost. However the prospectus is available for download from the college website www.purbanchalcollege.ac.in. Students have to apply online in the Samarth E-Govt. portal and submit the copy of application form in the college office along with all prescribed documents.

SELECTION OF CANDIDATES

Candidates shall be selected for admission on merit basis and reservation system is also maintained as per rule. An Admission committee is constituted to conduct the entire admission process and its decision shall be final in this regard. Selected candidates are to get themselves admitted on the stipulated date and time by paying all dues.

Selected candidates shall have to produce the original copy of all documents at the time of admission.

FREE ADMISSION

As per Govt. notification free admission will be provided to the students whose annual parental income from all sources is less than Rs. 2.00 lakh. If either of the parent (mother or father) of the student is working in the State Govt. / Central Govt. / Semi Govt. / State or Central Govt. undertaking, such students shall not be eligible under the scheme.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

- (i) An income certificate from the local Revenue Circle/Mauzadar.
- (ii) A declaration form duly signed by the student that neither of the parent (father or mother) is working in the State Govt. / Central Govt. / Semi Govt. / State or Central Govt. undertaking, etc. Such form will be supplied by the college authority during the time of admission.
- (iii) Photograph of a planting a sapling at the college or at his/her home should be submitted during admission. In order to be eligible for free admission in the second year, the student has to nurse the sapling and while seeking admission in to the second year shall have to submit a photograph of the same plant planted during the previous year which will be verified by the scrutiny committee.

▪ Power of the Admission Committee

The Admission Committee of the college shall have the power to enquire into the income of the family and if the committee is of the view that the income of the parent exceeds 2.00 lakh may cancel the admission of the candidate notwithstanding any reason thereof.

▪ Uniform

The students must maintain the following college uniform:

▪ **Identity Card:**

All students require to getting their identity cards issued at the time of their admission. They must keep identity cards at all times with them while in the college.

▪ **Students Association**

The Purbanchal College Students' Union (PCSU) the only bonafide students' body is allowed in the college campus. The objective of having this union body is to train the students' tolerance and democratic values by getting them involved in it. The office bearers of the union body are elected annually by the students from among themselves.

▪ **National Service Scheme and First Aid**

The National Service Scheme has its presence in the college with strength of 100 students volunteers. It instruments in the implementation of awareness camps related to social causes, cleanliness drive, etc. In these activities the NSS team of Purbanchal College, Silapathar has been actively rendering their services. It possesses minimum required first aid facility in time of urgent need especially for the students and hostel inmates.

▪ **ICT Enabled Class Room**

The college has ICT facilities for the students with the help of which the teachers demonstrate their lectures to the students with the help of modern tools. Till date the college has introduced ICT facilities in 6 (four) departments. In the near future the College aims at expanding the facilities.

▪ **Publications**

The Students' Union of the college publishes its mouthpiece entitled "Purbanchal College Magazine" annually. Besides, the college publishes a wall magazine named 'Saswata'. Moreover most of the department publishes their wall magazines to encourage the students to cultivate their literary activities.

- Cash award of **Rs. 2,500/-** along with certificate by the **Department of Commerce** to the student securing highest position in the honours subjects (Accounting & Finance, Banking & Insurance, Human Resource Management, Marketing) with aggregate of 65% in Final Examination.

▪ GENERAL RULES AND PROCEDURES

1. All rules and regulation will be followed as per guidelines of the University.
2. A student disciplinary committee maintains discipline among the students. Use of mobile phone and tobacco in any form are strictly prohibited inside the campus. Wearing of college uniform is compulsory. Student should always bring their identity card.
3. A student is not eligible to sit for university examination as regular candidate if he/ she has not attended minimum 80% lectures in each subject separately for theory and practical classes.
4. A student abstaining for classes continuously for 15 days or more during the session without any valid ground shall forfeit his/her seat.
5. Scholarship holders must have 80% attendance.
6. All examinations (Sessional exam./Seminar/ Group Discussion/ Assignment. Project Report) are conducted by Examination Committee of the College. Details of these tests/ Examinations are available in the academic calendar.
7. Departments will monitor the academic performance of each and every student throughout the year.
8. In case of semester system, makes of internal assessment will depend on their (students) performance in sessional examinations, home assignment, class attendance, seminar/ group discussions (conducted by concerned departments), etc.
